

For the largest Dutch e-commerce retailer, I was part of team Pets to build the new Horse application. This important application is used daily by +100 employees of Bol to update prices, promotions, delivery times and availability of millions of products listed on the Bol.com webshop.

- Developed fully functional front-end for Horse application with React (Next.js, v14, app router), TypeScript and SCSS modules
- Convert Figma designs to responsive pixel-perfect screens using the internal Bol Puik UI component library
- Created back-end for front-end in Java (Kotlin) to fetch all relevant data from multiple services within Bol to serve the FE
- Participating in code reviews, sprint reviews and retrospectives with the development team

















# Senior Full-stack Developer

June 2023 - September 2023

In this project I was working as a full-stack developer to deliver the MVP, but mostly focussed on the front-end of the project. Basically this crypto analytics platform is used for traders to spot the next x1000 memecoin based on multiple data points from the blockchain.

- Responsible for developing the front-end with TypeScript and React (Next.js, v13, app router)
- Using the TradeView charts to show the user crypto charts
- Refactored some code on the back-end with Node.js
- Convert Figma designs to responsive pixel-perfect screens using the HeroUI component library (formerly NextUI)















For the third biggest insurance company in the Netherlands, with more than 3.7 million policy holders, I was hired as a front-end developer to develop out the new "Vergoedingsservice" from scratch with React (Next.js) and TypeScript. In parallel of this project, I was also tasked to create the component UI library of CZ in Storybook. Consisting of the following tasks:

- Built a fully functional front-end for the new "Vergoedingsservice" of CZ, used by thousands of users daily
- Convert Figma designs to responsive pixel-perfect screens in React (Next.js), TypeScript and SCSS modules
- Developed a backend for front-end (BFF) in Node.js to fetch all the data from old Sitecore API to serve the new application
- Together with the Lead Front-end Developer, we build an UI component library from scratch with the use of Storybook
- Participating in code reviews, sprint reviews and retrospective with the development team
- Wrote extensive unit tests for UI components with Jest
- Ensured all UI components met accessibility best practices and achieved at least WCAG AA (A11Y) compliance

- Convert Figma designs of components to responsive pixel-perfect screens in jQuery, PHP (Twig) and Bootstrap

- Ensured all UI components met accessibility best practices and achieved at least WCAG AA (A11Y) compliance

As a contractor for Wunderman Thompson Commerce since October 25, 2021, I have been primarily tasked with working on the Ted Baker account. Ted Baker is a renowned luxury retail brand based in the United Kingdom. They brought me on board to work on the checkout flow for their new website. The technology stack for this project includes Next.js (React), Redux, SCSS, and comprehensive unit testing with Jest and Enzyme. This checkout system is utilized by 1.5 million users globally on an annual basis.

Following my work on the Ted Baker project, I was tasked with the development of a new webshop for DFS - a renowned furniture brand with over 200 locations in the UK, the Netherlands, and Spain. The technology employed for this webshop includes Next.js (React), Redux Thunk, and Material UI. Backend with Java. To ensure its functionality, I utilized React Testing Library and Jest for testing purposes. My responsibilities primarily included fixing bugs and ensuring seamless compatibility across a range of browsers and devices.

GoLuggo is part of Luggage Care and is a sheatlanent startup, which tries to eliminate the pain of carrying around luggage when you are travelling. Your luggage is being checked in at your door and will be delivered at your destination. Also I was responsible for some bug fixing for their React-Native application.

In the last few months, I have been working mostly on the goluggo.com platform. The most important feature of this platform, is the booking flow: customers can make a reservation here. The platform is built with React, Redux Saga, Styled Components and MaterialUI. Together with the development team of Luggage Care, we have been working according to the SCRUM methodology.
